that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actua'ly beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.02 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NF4 SW4, Section 19, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. M., 1680 feet North and 1640 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,
