## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LLOYD G. DUYCK

of Rt. 2 Box 485, Cornelius, State of Oregon, 97113, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-44526, Permit No. R-5273

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 82.8 acres and supplemental irrigation of 151.1 acres

under Permit No. 33317 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 29, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the River-SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Geiger DLC 47, Section 9; Reservoir-SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Emerick DLC 46, Section 4, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., River-990 feet North and 2230 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 9; Reservoir-2260 feet South and 2900 feet East from the NW Corner, Emerick DLC 46.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited ~~one~~-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5273, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
