a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 23.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35179 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.29 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEK NEW, as projected within Gibson DLC 44, Section 13, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 280 feet South and 1890 feet East from the Westerly NW Corner of Gibson DLC 44.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the iirigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
