CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **SYLVESTER VAN LOO**

of Rt. 2 Box 124, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, 97116, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Application No. R-47773, Permit No. R-5769

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.2 acres and supplemental irrigation of 28.7 acres

under Permit No. 35780 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 8, 1970 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.1 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Beaks DLC 79, Section 32, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M., Reservoir-650 feet North and 490 feet East; Craek-700 feet North and 300 feet East; both from the Southerly SW Corner, Beaks DLC 79.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per-acre, a diversion of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
