## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 15 OF DOUGLAS COUNTY

of Days Creek , State of Oregon, 97429 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 2.84 acres and school use

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17547 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 12, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.06 c.f.s. for school use during the irrigation season only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 SW2, Section 10, T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 60 feet North and 90 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lunds, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2^{1/2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.48 acre and school use SWk SWk As projected within G. Day DLC 47 Section 10

T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

2.36 acres and school use NW4 NW4
As projected within G. Day DLC 47
Section 15
T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use of water and change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 13, 1965, and together with certificate 32373 supersedes certificate of water right issued to Albert M. Rowe and recorded at Page 24101, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
