## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** OWEN DOWNHILL, JR.

of P.O. Box 859, Canyonville, State of Oregon, 97417, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigating 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 1077 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 10, 1912 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 27, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 2640 feet North and 2030 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 27  
T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 19, 1974 and together with certificate 43745 supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to T. C. Shaw, E. W. Elliott, and Mrs. Mary Odle, and recorded at Page 1306, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
