## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

RALPH WINNIFORD

of Rt. 2 Box 1080, Roseburg , State of Cregon, 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 25.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 24886 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $S^{[1]} \zeta S^{[2]} \zeta$ , as projected within Barrett DLC 54, Section 29, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 540 feet South and 520 feet West from the NE Corner of said DLC 54.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

19.5 acres NW4 SW4

2.0 acres NEW SEW

3.0 acres SW& SW&

0.5 acre SE's SE's

Both projected within C. Grover DLC 43 Both pro Section 28

Both projected within C. Grover DLC 43

Section 29 T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 29486, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 25, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3480.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to URS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
