## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of Grant , at page 461; that the priority of the the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15 right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre foot per acre thereafter; total five acre feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW NE, Section 25, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M., 1020 feet South and 740 feet East from the N's Corner of Section 25.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.3 acres NEW NWW 1.6 acres NW NW Section 25 T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered February 28, 1969 and together with certificate 35918 supersedes certificate of water right issued to Bradford C. Trowbridge and recorded at Page 25925, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described,, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed by the Water Policy Review Board.
