that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located in the SW2 NE%, Section 25, T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M., 30 feet North and 160 feet West from the SE Corner of the SW4 NE% of Section 25.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described., and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed Policy Review Board.
