## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That J. H. PARKER estate

of Baker , State of

Oregon

has a right to the use of

the waters of

Powder River, tributary of Snake River

for the purpose of

the irrigation of 380 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker ... County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1867 for 80 acres; 1902 for 140 acres and 1867 for 160 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Nine: 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Nine: 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 30 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Ten: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter: 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 40 acresin the Southea t quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Six, Township Eight South, Range Forty East of Willamette Merician, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
