## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

WALLACE JOHNSON

of Rt. 3 Box 1268, Hood River, State of Oregon, 97031, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
Indian Creek

a tributary of Hood River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 20.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 200; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1876

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-eightieth of one  
cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation, and that  
the total quantity diverted during the irrigation season shall not exceed three  
acre feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 9, T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.,  
710 feet South and 820 feet East from the Center  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of Section 9.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

20.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 9  
T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an  
order of the State Engineer entered April 19, 1973, and together with certificate  
39833 supersedes certificate of water right issued to Grace H. Hilles and  
recorded at Page 14972, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies  
established by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed

this date November 23, 1976.
