CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

HARRY E. AND NORLENE E. WARDLE

of 8916 E. Evans Creek Rd., Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97357, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic, stock, and irrigation of 9.8 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1896;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.,
720 feet South and 1250 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of Section 11.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

- 4.4 acres in that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
lying north of Evans Creek and
South of the county road
- 5.4 acres in that part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
lying north of Evans Creek and
South of the county road
Section 11
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered August 22, 1969, and supersedes certificate
of water right issued to Edna Van Goethem Galinat and recorded at Page 32790,
Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established
by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed

this date November 23, 1976.
