## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

GLENN E. ELLIS

of 22705 Evans Creek Rd., Central Point , State of Oregon, 97502 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork of Evans Creek

a tributary of Evans Creek, tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 20.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 13651 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 3, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SER SWR, Section 33, T. 33 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 460 feet North and 1550 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 33; SER NWR, Section 4, T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 1590 feet South and 1700 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres NW4 NW4 10.0 acres SW4 NW4 Section 4 T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion of water from East Fork Ewans Creek approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 7, 1971, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to Harry and Ellen Reed and recorded at Page 14645, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
