CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

OLA M. VAN DYKE

of 226 Old Pacific Hwy. So., Talent, State of Oregon, 97540, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Wagner Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 6.1 acres and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1852;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Wagner DLC 64,
Section 26, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 530 feet North and 350 feet West from
the SE Corner of Wagner DLC 64.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

6.1 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within Wagner DLC 64
Section 26
T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered April 17, 1972, and supersedes certificate
of water right issued to James Foxhall and recorded at Page 16049, Volume 13,
State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
