CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

LEO J. AND MARIANNE O. VAN DIJK

of 1609 Jackson Road, Ashland, State of Oregon, 97520, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Bear Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 10.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1860;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 38 S., R. 1 E., W. M.,
1335 feet North and 95 feet West from the SE Corner of DLC 48.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

4.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within DLC 48
3.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within DLC 49
1.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within DLC 48
Section 32
T. 38 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
April 9, 1973, and supersedes certificate of water right 37366.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
