CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES BOLLIN

of 6502 Meath Circle, Huntington Beach, State of California, 92646, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed gulch

a tributary of Sardine Creek for the purpose of stock and domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 26500 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 21, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second; provided that the use of water for stock be limited to the period when the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 810 feet South and 800 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 25, 1973, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to Olav K. Lokken and recorded at Page 31771, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
