CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Baker

for the purpose of Salmon Creek, tributary of Powder River, and Powder River, tributary of Snake River

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1871 for 41 acres and 1873

for 24 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decrees. This irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

17 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 24 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Fourteen and 24 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
