CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That KENNETH S. JOCHEM

of 8881 East Evans Creek Rd., Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97357, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic, stock, and irrigation of 10.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1896;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE~~1~~ SE~~1~~, Section 10, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.,
1480 feet South and 10 feet West from the E~~1~~ Corner of Section 10.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

10.0 acres NW~~1~~ SW~~1~~
Section 11
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Described as follows:

Commencing at a stake 5 chains East of the quarter section corner between
Sections 10 and 11, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Jackson County, Oregon, on the
East and West center line of Section 11, and from said beginning point thence
East 6 chains; thence South 12.90 chains to the Westerly side of the county
road; thence following the Westerly side of the county road South 39° West
9.40 chains to the SE corner of a certain 10 acre tract under contract to
one G. W. Brandon; thence North to the East line of said tract 20 chains to
the point of beginning, containing 10 acres more or less.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered March 18, 1974, and supersedes certificate
of water right issued to Margaret Hughbanks and recorded at Page 32789, Volume 24,
State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established
by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed

this date November 23, 1976.
