CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT K. WALES

of 8746 E. Evans Creek Rd., Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97537, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic use, stock, and irrigation of 10.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1896;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.,
1480 feet South and 10 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of Section 10.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

10.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Described as follows:

Commencing at the quarter corner between Sections 10 and 11, T. 35 S., R. 4 W.,
W. M.; thence running South 20 chains; thence East 5 chains; thence North 20
chains; thence West 5 chains to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an
order of the State Engineer entered March 12, 1974, and supersedes certificate
of water right issued to William E. and Amy Lange and recorded at Page 32791,
Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established
by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed

this date November 23, 1976.
