of Rogue River , State of Oregon, 97537 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 19.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 6124 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1923

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.242 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NW4, Section 5, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 650 feet North and 2610 feet East from the W4 Corner of Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.4 acres SW4 NW4 18.0 acres SE4 NW≤ Section 5 T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate represents that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 7488, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates as modified by an order of the State Engineer entered on January 28, 1966, NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 21, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3117. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.
