## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MAUD KUBLI

of Applegate, State of Oregon, 97530, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 90.0 acres, domestic use, and stock use in Tract No. 1, and mining  
in Tract No. 2

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1866 for Tract No. 1, and 1858 for Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.26 cubic feet per  
second for Tract No. 1, and 9.50 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 2.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.,  
2510 feet South and 3370 feet West from the NE Corner of the George Long DLC 39  
for Tract No. 1 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 1950 feet  
South and 1800 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 29 for Tract No. 2.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior  
certificate of water right recorded at Page 16238, Volume 13, State Record of Water  
Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water  
Resources Director entered June 7, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3377  
but does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.  
This certificate does confirm the change in point of diversion approved by an order  
of the State Engineer entered February 15, 1966 approving transfer application  
No. H-160.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established  
by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed

this date November 23, 1976.
