## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MARGERY W. OVERACKER

of 601 Latigo Ranch Rd., Williams , State of Oregon, 97544 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Right fork (West fork) of Williams Creek

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 12.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2726 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SW4, Section 3, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 120 feet South and 680 feet East from the W4 Corner of Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.0 acres NW2 SW2 Section 3 T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 10, 1966, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. W. Rowley and Phoebe Rowley and recorded at Page 1240, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
