CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **HIGHLAND DITCH COMPANY**

of **Wilderville**, State of **Oregon, 97543**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **Applegate River**

a tributary of **Rogue River**
 irrigating **62.0 acres**

for the purpose of

under Permit No. **2805** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 13, 1915**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.77 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 4921, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered September 10, 1975, May 14, 1976, and May 17, 1976 which canceled the right for the irrigation of 10.0 acres and approved changes in points of diversion for the irrigation of 43.0 acres.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described., and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
