CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MADELINE LACKNER

of Rt. 1 Box 91, Scio, State of Oregon, 97374, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bilyeu Creek

a tributary of Thomas Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 43.8 acres

under Permit No. 26103 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 2, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within John Bilyeu DLC 50, Section 9, T. 10 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 2060 feet North and 320 feet East from the SW Corner of Bilyeu DLC 50.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	10.1 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
12.9 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	9.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Both projected within J. Bilyeu DLC 50 Section 9	Both projected within J. Bilyeu DLC 50 Section 16 T. 10 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 3, 1974, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to Madeline Lackner and recorded at Page 32468, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
