## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN L. JORDON

of Westfall, State of Oregon, 97920, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
Bully Creek

a tributary of Malheur River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 30.23 acres and supplemental irrigation of 18.07 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 226; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1888 for Tract #1; 1892 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1½ acre feet per acre  
in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre in any 30-day  
period after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season,  
diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per  
acre.

The point of diversion is located in the SW¼ SW¼, Section 9, T. 18 S., R. 43 E., W. M.,  
1660 feet South and 320 feet East from the W¼ Corner of Section 9.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion  
approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 30, 1970, and supersedes  
certificate of water right heretofore issued to Catherine L. Sheahan and recorded  
at Page 7011, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established  
by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed
