CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Ironside , State of Oregon, 97908 , has a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek, tributary of Malheur River, Boulder and Little Boulder Creeks

a tributary of Willow Creek irrigation of 308.0 acres, domestic use, and stock use

for the purpose of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from the year 1874 for the irrigation of 80.0 acres, 1877 for the irrigation of 75.0 acres, and 1879 for the irrigation of 133.0 acres, that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 7.70 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 3.86 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 924 acre feet.

The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4; SE4 SE5, Section 15, T. 14 S., R. 39 E., W. M., 970 feet North and 1885 feet West; 1210 feet North and 680 feet West, both from the SE Corner of Section 15.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 9, 1967 as well as to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 1589, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of the same order approving transfer application No. L-76.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed Review Board.
