CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GENE O. PIERCE

of Box 36, Heppner, State of Oregon, 97835, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.4 acres

under Permit No. 3529 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 23, 1917 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 2 S., R. 26 E., W. M., 2020 feet North and 2500 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.4 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 35
T. 2 S., R. 26 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved December 13, 1973, and together with certificate 40398 supersedes certificate of water right 3388.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
