## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

of 1634 SW Alder St., Portland, State of Oregon, 97208, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cedar Creek

a tributary of Three Rivers, Nestucca River for the purpose of domestic and fish hatchery

under Permit No. 6641 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 24, 1924 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 19, T. 4 S., R. 9 W., W. M., 100 feet South and 300 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered May 7, 1971, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to Oregon State Game Commission and recorded at Page 7405, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
