CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLARENCE E. QUIRK

of 716 West 9th Street, The Dalles, State of Oregon, 97058, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Fifteen Mile Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 30.0 acres

under Permit No. 9009 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 24, 1929

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, T. 2 N., R. 15 E., W. M., 1210 feet South and 1120 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 31; NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 31, T. 2 N., R. 15 E., W. M., 2350 feet North and 3060 feet West from the E 1/2 Corner of Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 1.8 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
- 14.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
- 4.6 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
- 8.8 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
- 0.8 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4

T. 2 N., R. 15 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 5, 1969 and to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 33034, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of the same order which approved transfer application No. Q-4.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
