## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** BESSIE GREENER

of Halfway, State of Oregon, 97834, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek and waste water

a tributary of Pine Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 31.2 acres and supplemental irrigation of 50.0 acres

under Permit No. 31732 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 29, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.03 cubic feet per second, being 0.5 c.f.s. from Spring Creek and 1.53 c.f.s. from waste water

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10, NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, T. 8 S., R. 46 E., W. M., Spring Creek-1540 feet South and 10 feet West; 2390 feet South and 10 feet East, both from the NW Corner of Section 11; Waste Water from the NW Corner of Section 11 to a point 1530 feet south.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $4\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
