of Sitkum Rt. Box 20, Myrtle Point , State of Oregon, 97458 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Coquille River

a tributary of Coquille River irrigation of 4.5% acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 9811 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 15, 1930

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (NEW SEW); Lot 8 (SWW SEW), Section 4, T. 29 S., R. 12 W., W. M., 2380 feet North and 750 feet West; 560 feet North and 2190 feet West, both from the SE Corner of Section 4; 380 feet North and 920 feet West from the SE Corner of the SWW SEW of Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.51 acres Lot 8 (SW2 SE2) - Caudle
0.50 acre Lot 8 (SW2 SE2) - Christensen
0.50 acre Lot 8 (SW2 SE2) - Fenn

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved or 1 29, 1965 and together with special orders recorded in Volume 13, Page 472 and Volume 14, Page 122 supersedes certificate of water right 9264.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
