CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Box 2131, Portland, State of Oregon, 97208, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Squaw Creek and reservoir constructed under application No. R-45225, Permit No. R-5315

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of
irrigation of 27.0 acres and fish culture

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1886;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per
second, being 0.54 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.02 c.f.s. for fish culture.

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 17, T. 15 S., R. 10 E., W. M.,
600 feet South and 1170 feet East from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 17; NW 1/4 SW 1/4,
Section 9, T. 15 S., R. 10 E., W. M., 1100 feet South and 210 feet East from CR
the W 1/4 Corner of Section 9.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

14.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
9.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 8
Fish Culture and 4.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 9
T. 15 S., R. 10 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use of water and change in point
of diversion as well as to describe that portion of the water right not modified
by the order entered February 5, 1969 and supersedes certificate 31422.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
