CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILLIAM E. WILLIAMS

of South Myrtle Cr. Rt., Myrtle Creet, State of Oregon, 97457, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River irrigation of 18.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 21088 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE% NW%, Section 29, T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 650 feet South and 2530 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.25 c.f.s.,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre NE% NE% 14.8 acres NW NEW 0.4 acre SW4 NE% 2.3 acres NE% NW% Section 29 T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate 22704 so as to correctly describe the lands irrigated and to describe that portion of the water right not modified by the provisions of the order entered January 9, 1974 approving transfer No. 2587.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
