CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MILO BULLOCK

of Kellogg Route, Box 81, Oakland , State of Oregon, 97462 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 35.7 acres

for the purpose of

under P* mit No. 25778 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 5, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.4 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE4 SW4), Section 2, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 620 feet North and 1420 feet East; 40 feet North and 2250 feet East; both from the SW Corner of Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the Umpqua River is 525.0 c.f.s. or more at tidewater,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.9 acres Lot 1 (SWA SWA)
5.8 acres Lot 1 (SEA SWA)

16.4 acres Lot 1 (NE% NE%)

This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of diversion approved December 14, 1973 and supersedes certificate of water right 31847.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
