CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLENN G. AND LORIS L. BUTLER

of Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon, 97457 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 20.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 25864 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 25, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.255 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4, as projected within Adams DLC 42, Section 33, T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the South Umpqua River is 60.0 cubic feet per second or more at its mouth,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre NE% NW%
0.6 acre NW% NW%
14.6 acres SW% NW%
5.0 acres SE% NW%
All projected within Henry Adams DLC 42
Section 33
T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate 31145 so as to correctly describe the place of use.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
