## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DALE L. FOSTER

of P.O. Box 196, Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon, 97457 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring and an unnamed stream

a tributary of South Myrtle Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden and the irrigation of 1.5 acres

under Permit No. 33113 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 28, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use and 0.02 c.f.s. from unnumed stress for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Stream-SE's SW; Spring-NE's SW; Section 19, T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Stream-270 feet South and 800 feet West; Spring-180 feet South and 690 feet West, both from the NE Corner of Carson DLC 42.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation sesson of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
