CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CECIL SANDERS AND HARLEY FINNEY

of 3062 Anderson Creek Rd., Talent, State of Oregon, 97540, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Anderson Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 5.0 acres, domestic use, and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1901;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot
per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33,
T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 240 feet North and 230 feet West; 380 feet North and
70 feet East, both from the SE Corner of Section 32.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

Domestic, Stock, & 4.9 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32

0.1 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 33
T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion
as well as to describe that portion of the water right or modified by the order
entered September 16, 1966 and supersedes certificate of water right 16086.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
