CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

EAGLE POINT SCHOOL DISTRICT

of P.O. Box 548, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, 97524, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Little Butte Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 6.1 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1883;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Cameron DLC 45,
Section 3, T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 1100 feet North and 780 feet West from the
E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of Section 3.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

4.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2
1.7 acres Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 3
T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion, place of
use, and character of use of water approved August 15, 1969 and together with
certificate 36604 supersedes certificate 34845.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
