## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That **ELWYN L. AND BETTY M. ROWE**

of 14855 East Evans Creek Rd., Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97537, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 7.0 acres

under Permit No. 6124 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1923 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 30 feet South and 1875 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 33, T. 34 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 33  
T. 34 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved August 10, 1971, and together with certificate 37661 supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 7484.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
