## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK GATES, JR.

of 6100 Dunlap Rd., Jacksonville, State of Oregon, 97530, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 10.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per  
second

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.,  
790 feet South and 1235 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner of Section 28.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

10.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 28  
T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by  
an order of the State Engineer entered September 5, 1973 and supersedes certificate  
of water right issued to J. P. Rankin and recorded at Page 16248, Volume 13, State  
Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
