of South Myrtle, Box 133, Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon, 97457 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River irrigating 2.37 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 4803 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 25, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4, Section 22, T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 790 feet North and 1780 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth**of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of the under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.37 acres SWk SEk Section 22 T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved February 25, 1975, and together with certificate 44047 supersedes certificate 37360.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
