CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DORIS MIRACLE

of 4271 Rockydale Road, Cave Junction, State of Oregon, 97523, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.2 acres

under Permit No. 4449 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M., 1190 feet North and 1070 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2
T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved August 22, 1969 and together with certificate 36486 supersedes certificate of water right 12313.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
