CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

GEORGE E. BRETZ

of 101 Panther Gulch Rd., Williams, State of Oregon, 97544, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 6.2 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1903;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M.,
130 feet South and 610 feet West from the NW Corner of Murphy DLC 40.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

6.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
by an order of the State Engineer entered August 13, 1974 and together with
certificate 43999 supersedes certificate of water right issued to Louise C.
Selleck and recorded at Page 16253, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right
Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
