## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That****RALPH JOSEPH HOCHENDORER AND  
HENRY A. KEISECKER**

of 1498 Applegate Rd., Grants Pass, State of Oregon, 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 6.9 acres

under Permit No. E-85 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 25, 1910 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 1080 feet North and 970 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.9 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
6.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 20  
T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved October 30, 1970 and July 22, 1971 and together with certificate 37382 supersedes certificate of water right 2067.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
