CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LLOYD DUYCK

of Rt. 2 Box 485, Cornelius, State of Oregon, 97113, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 3

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 94.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 233.9 acres

under Permit No. G-4751 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 20, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.31 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Emerick DLC 46, Section 5, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 1560 feet South and 1700 feet East from the NW Corner, Emerick DLC 46.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 Sec 4, as projected within Emerick DLC 46, Section 5, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 1560 feet South and 1700 feet East from the NW Corner, Emerick DLC 46.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,
