a tributary of Yamhill River irrigation of 10.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 13718 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 15, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NWL, as projected within Edson DLC 38, Section 5, T. 5 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 410 feet North and 440 feet East from the most Easterly SE Corner of Martin DLC 37.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.8 acres SE% SW%
2.2 acres SW% SE%
Both projected within Garrison DLC 40
Section 5
T. 5 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved July 3, 1973 and together with certificate 39612 supersedes certificate of water right 33397.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
