CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **DORIS MIRACLE**

of 4271 Rockydale Road, Cave Junction, State of Oregon, 97523, has
a right to the use of the waters of
East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of
irrigation of 3.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per
second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from
April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.,
1190 feet North and 1070 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 2.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

3.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2
T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
August 22, 1969 and together with certificate 36485 supersedes certificate of
water right 13884.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
