CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOSEPH N. HERSHREGER

of P. O. Box 786, Canby , State of Oregon, 97013 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Molalla and Pudding Rivers (Willamatte River) for the purpose of irrigating 12.8 acres

under Permit No. G-1811 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.16 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWA SEX, Section 7, T. 4 S., R. 1 E., W. M., Well located 800 feet North and 160 feet West from the SE Corner, NWA SEX.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.0 acres NWk SEk 4.8 acres SWk SEk Section 7 T. 4 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by prior certificate 34965, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order entered on July 10, 1975.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
