that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 cubic fact per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW SE, as projected within Seely DLC 57, Section 32, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 850 feet North and 1780 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to per-serve; appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others,

and shall

conform to such reasonable retation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
