of Prineville , State of Oregon, 97754 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River

a tributary of Deschutes River irrigation of 208.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2955 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 27, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **2.6 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWK NEK, Section 2, T. 17 S., R. 20 E., W. M., 810 feet South and 1820 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

25.0 acres NE% SE%
10.0 acres SW% SE%
40.0 acres SE% SE%

2.0 acres SW% NW%
1.0 acre SE% NW%
35.0 acres NE% SW%

25.0 acres NW, SW, 25.0 acres SEL SW, 10.0 acres NW, SEL 35.0 acres SW, SEL Section 34 T. 16 S., R. 20 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved December 4, 1973 and along with certificate 43953 and special order entered April 19, 1973 supersedes certificate of water right 7108.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
